growth promoters

- Improved growth rate
- Improved feed efficiency
- Improved carcass quality

growth promoters

- health conscious consumers
- trimmer carcass

growth promoters

- anabolic steroids / HGP
 - natural & synthetic
 - mostly testosterone derivatives
- beta adrenoceptor agonists
 - clenbuterol (illegal)
 - ractopamine (pigs with SOP)
- somatotropin (BST)

more growth promoters

- antibiotic (feed additives)
- rumen modifiers
 - ionophores – e.g. monensin
- probiotics
 - *Lactobacillus* spp

hormonal growth promoters

- Good nutrition is essential
- Record keeping required
- European Union bans use

hormonal growth promoters

- androgens
 - testosterone
 - trenbolone acetate
- oestrogens
 - oestradiol
 - zeranol
- progestagens
 - progesterone

Hormonal Growth Promotants

- mechanism of action
 - increase nitrogen retention
 - decrease catabolism
 - growth hormone

hormonal growth promoters

- rate of gain ↑ 10-15%
- more muscling
 - thicker fibrils
 - may be tougher meat
- less fat (wastage)

side effects

- increased mounting
- rectal & vaginal prolapse
- oedema
- udder development
- abortion if pregnant

hormonal growth promoters

- Compudose 100, 200, 400
 - Oestradiol benzoate
- Implus Magnum
 - Oestradiol benzoate
 - Trenbolone acetate

hormonal growth promoters

- Revalor – H and Revalor – S:
 - Oestradiol benzoate
 - Trenbolone acetate

hormonal growth promoters

- **Synovex – S, – H, - Plus:**
 - Oestradiol monobenzoate
 - Trenbolone acetate
- **Synovex – C**
 - Oestradiol monobenzoate
 - Progesterone

uses

- **Steers, Heifers (non-breeding)**
 - Compu dose, Implus, Revalor & Synovex
- **Calves**
 - Compu dose, Implus, Revalor & Synovex
- **Bulls**
 - (zeranol - Ralgro® no NZ license)

MAF Requirements

- HGPs are for use in cattle only.
- HGPs are administered by a veterinarian or trained technician.
- HGPs implanted in the ear only

MAF Requirements

- **ear tags**
 - MAF approved ear tag
 - secondary ID tag
 - orange "growth promoter" tag
 - lost ear tags must be replaced
 - MAF approved ear tags must not be used for any other purpose

hormonal growth promoters



MAF Requirements

- Records completed at time of implantation and kept for 5 years
- Fines up to \$20,000 for individuals and up to \$100,000 for companies for non-compliance

anabolic steroids

- **uses**

- convalescing animals
- renal disease (anaemia)
- performance enhancers

- **products**

- ethylestrenol
- nandrolone
- stanozolol



anabolic steroids

- Stimulate erythropoiesis

- Bone marrow

- Stimulate appetite

- Muscle mass increased

- Promote healing

contraindications

- Anticoagulants (warfarin)

- Diabetes - ↓ insulin need

- Liver disease

consider

- Monitor liver function (tests)

- Monitor weight

- Appetite

- Blood – serum electrolytes

somatotropin

- peptide
 - must be injected daily
- use
 - BST used overseas
 - PST registered in NZ but not used
 - EST registered but no real indications
